

## Model Fiesta 40 Pre-Registration How-To

ModelFiesta 40 is coming up soon and IPMS Alamo Squadron is pleased to inform you, the reader, that you will be able to take advantage of our Pre-Registration Program. You are invited to Pre-Register your entries via email beginning October 15th and terminating January 6 at 6pm, CST. ModelFiesta is scheduled for Jan 8, 2022, at the New Braunfels Civic Center in New Braunfels, Texas.

Pre-registering your entries allows you a quicker "registration experience" when you check-in on the day of the event. There is also a \$3 discount of your total registration fee for those who pre-register when you check-in on the day of the event.

When visiting the website (http://www.modelfiesta.com/registration.html), you will see the Model Registration Summary Form or MRSF (see example in next page) and the Individual Model Entry Form (or IMEF). Once downloaded, information can be entered directly into text boxes on the forms and saved.

Your IPMS # is not a requirement but if you are a member, please enter your membership number.

Having your phone number on file allows us to call you in case of a question about your entries, or on the day of the event if there is a need to contact you about one of your entries.

Be sure to bring the printouts of the Individual Model Entry Form (IMEF) with you to display in each of your model entries.

Receipt of your Summary Form will be acknowledged and additional instructions regarding what to do with all your forms will be e-mailed to you a few days after receipt.

Pre-Registration payment will take place at the Pre-Registration Station on the day of the event.

## KIT REVIEW: ORANGE HOBBY'S 1/72 SCALE F-35C LIGHTNING II

I've finally acquired all 3 versions of the F-35 Lightning II with the F-35C

being the most difficult to find. While there

are plenty of 1/72<sup>nd</sup> kits of the F-35A and F-35B, the only F-35C was a 1/48<sup>th</sup> scale by Kitty Hawk. But as always persistence pays off and I finally found the only current kit of the Navy's F-35C in 1/72<sup>nd</sup>. The kit is by the Chinese company, Orange Hobby, and I purchased it on-line from BNA Model World (bnamodelworld.com). I also



purchased the mask set for the F-35C from BNA Model World which will make painting the RAM material on the jet much easier.

The kit consists of 5 sprues of finely molded light gray plastic, one clear sprue for the cockpit canopy and clear lens for sensors, and a small PE with seatbelts and engine exhaust fan.

The kit also contains the parts and PE to build a USN carrier deck tractor (see photo next page). The upper and lower halves of the fuselage have slightly raised surfaces for the RAM material. The wheel wells have plenty of

detail and all the pylons and doors have excellent detail also. Flash is minimal to non-existent and ejector marks are on the hidden side of the parts so cleanup should be easy and quick.

You can build the kit with the wings folded or extended, open or closed weapons bay, cockpit, and landing gear, attached gun pod or missiles only, and include pylons for those who wish to build the F-35C in "beast" mode. Two AIM-9X Sidewinder and 2 AIM-120C AMRAM missiles are included. However, the only way to show the missile armament is to assemble the weapon





bays open with the AIM-120C mounted or include the AIM-9X mounted on a weapon pylon on the wing. Also included is the GAU-22A Gun pod which provides the F-35C's only gun. Additional weapons for the "beast" mode weapons pylons are not provided and if you build the kit that way, a trip to the spares box or purchase of modern

weapons kit will be needed.

Assembly instructions are in an easy-to-follow step-by-step process. The instructions use extensive pictographs with all parts called out by part number and recommended paint color (if needed) for the part. There is no recommended paint numbers provided, only the generic color name i.e., flat white, flat black, dark gray, etc... so as always check your references. The instructions include a separate full sized twosided black and white sheet showing

decal placement for all three versions of the aircraft. First is the test aircraft, either CF-03 or CF-05, all in grays and the third version is for the U.S. Navy's fleet replacement squadron, VFA-101 Grim Reapers, Modex # 101 which at least has some color other than gray to it. I have not seen any aftermarket decals for the 1/72<sup>nd</sup> F-35C yet, but since the Navy now has at least two operational squadrons I hope to see some soon.

A recommended purchase is the masking kit for the F-35C by Orange Hobby which I purchased at BNA Model World. [Photo #7] The masks consist of 3 separate sheets of

individually numbered masks and the instructions (4 sheets) show every mask by number and placement on the aircraft. This will greatly simplify painting the complex RAM patterns on the aircraft and look forward to building this aircraft later this year.




