




Modelling the Movies

STINSON TEXAS AIR MUSEUM EXHIBITS By Stg. Rolf Stibbe

During a recent visit to Stinson Field's Texas Air Museum, 433rd Airlift Wing Technical I noticed where I could lend some of my modeling talents to assist in upgrading some of the museum displays.

My efforts consisted of an impromptu 'refurbishment' of several model aircraft on display. A 1/72 Boeing B-17E 'Peggy Dee '43' paying tribute to Private First Class Emma Jane Burroughs Windham who lost her life in a B-17.

Two 1/48 model jet fighters, namely a South Vietnamese F-5E and North Vietnamese Mig 21 were also repainted and marked.

The museum graciously gave me 3 existing P47 Thunderbolt fighters from their vast collection to restore. Each was stripped and repainted to represent the Mexican Expeditionary Fighter Group (Escuadrón 201) in the South Pacific in 1945.

There are two more aircraft models, refurbished on display pedestals sporting the colors of the Mexican Air Force (**FAM**), a P47 and Dauntless Dive Bomber. I purchased the great AZTEC decals and created a 1/48 scale AT-6 Texan that attacked a German U-boat off the coast of Mexico.

This will add a very interesting piece of history to the museum, no doubt.




